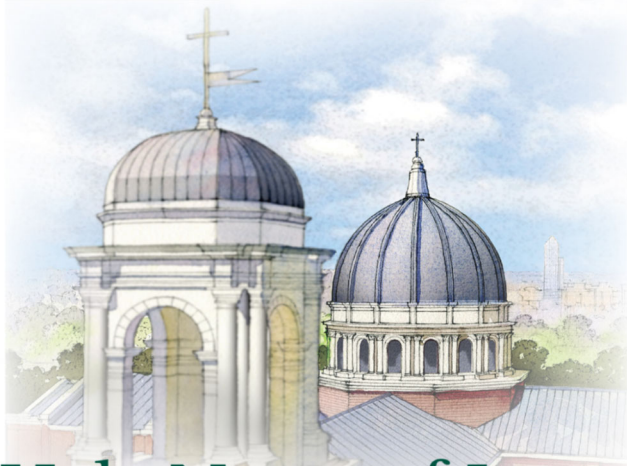
NOTE: All other meals or any optional tours/museums during the trip will be at your expense.

Bishop Zarama to be installed Aug. 29

In anticipation of the installation of The Most Reverend Luis Rafael Zarama as sixth Bishop of Raleigh, evening prayer will be celebrated by The Most Reverend Wilton Gregory, Archbishop of Atlanta on August 28, 7 p.m. at Holy Name of Jesus Cathedral, Raleigh. Bishop Zarama will greet guests afterwards. **Open to the public.**

The installation Mass, which will be livestreamed at www.dioceseofraleigh.org/livestream, begins at 2 p.m. Archbishop Wilton Gregory of Atlanta, which is the province to which the Diocese of Raleigh belongs, will preside over the installation.

Bishop Zarama, 58, comes to Raleigh after most recently serving in the Archdiocese of Atlanta as an auxiliary bishop. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1993; he was ordained to the episcopacy in 2009.

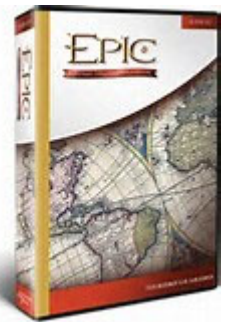

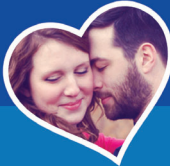
